Media Release

Henderson Police arrested Michael Jason “Jay” Randolph for Strangulation, Domestic Violence Related, after they investigated an altercation in the Randolph home.

The adult victim, Brecken Randolph, called 911 on May 30 around 5:30pm. He met officers at the police station and told them he had left the house after being assaulted by his father, Jay Randolph.

Brecken said a verbal dispute turned physical when Jay Randolph pushed him against a window and placed both hands around his neck. Brecken said Jay applied pressure on his neck with enough force that his breathing was impeded. Brecken said Jay applied pressure for approximately 1 minute before letting go. Brecken had marks on his neck that were reportedly from the incident. An ambulance crew responded to the police station to examine Brecken. He did not require further medical treatment at the time.

Officers responded to the home at 1300 Loeb St and spoke with Jay Randolph. He denied strangling his son but said there was an altercation where both men pushed each other. Based on the statements and physical evidence available at the time, officers placed Jay Randolph under arrest for Strangulation 1st Degree, Domestic Violence Related (KRS 508.170).

The investigation into the altercation that predicated the alleged strangulation is ongoing.

Presumption of Innocence Notice: The fact that a person has been arrested or charged with a crime is merely an accusation, and the defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty in a court of law.
