## Media Release

On the morning of August 6<sup>th</sup>, HPD officers were dispatched to the area of US Hwy 60 and Pebble Creek Dr for an animal cruelty complaint. The 911 caller said they saw someone throw kittens out of a van. Officers responded and recovered two deceased kittens at the scene. The suspect was not located.

HPD is investigating this as an animal cruelty case. Potential witnesses would have been around Hwy 60 and Pebble Creek to Barret Blvd between 9:25am and 9:35am. The caller said the van was a gray or silver Honda Odyssey in decent condition. The van was last seen traveling west on HWY 60 headed towards Barret Blvd.

In addition to eyewitnesses, HPD is seeking video from that area that would show westbound traffic during the listed time frame.
